PW NEWS - Thank Offering Sunday, November 14, 2021

Since 1888, Presbyterian Women have expressed their deep sense of gratitude for God's blessings in their lives by giving back to people in their communities and around the world. Over the last 33 years, Presbyterian Women has granted nearly \$27 million to more than 1,600 different projects at home and around the world through the PW Thank Offering. \$7,350 will be given to the Children's Advocacy Center in Hammond, LA. The grant will provide elements that enhance the Calming Center such as a sensory wall with interactive tools, a calming corner, custom seating in the waiting area, and color changing mood tiles. Puerta Abierta (Open Door) and Libros Abiertos(Open Books) in Santiago, Guatemala will receive \$50,000. The grant will provide funding to reach 3,200 students through intensive support, training and professional development for Guatemalan teachers. This will increase literacy and educational success for indigenous children where schools are without books and resources.
